### *Notes:*

- The weeks listed are guidelines only – it could well be that the teaching programme has to be altered and thus the dates may be changed – any changes should be indicated in writing to students and the school's weekly bulletin updated
- As a rule subjects which are mainly exam-based should not have internal assessment in Term Four; Internally-assessed subjects should a minimum of assessment in Term Four
- Many of the assignments in some subjects are long term, and the date given is the deadline date. Students are encouraged not to leave such assignments to the last minute
- Many assessments take place during class time and are a natural progression from the teaching – students are not expected to do extra work beyond the normal class period/homework
