## **BOARDING SCHOLARSHIPS 2012**

### **Conditions and Regulations of Scholarships**

The Board of Governors is offering Boarding Scholarships to students who are **new** to the College. The scholarships are intended for students of outstanding ability.

1. In academic, spiritual, cultural, sporting, service/leadership areas who otherwise would not be able to attend Scots College. Candidates must be New Zealand citizens or residents.
2. All short-listed applicants will be required to attend an interview. The date and time of the interview will be advised by the Headmaster's PA.
3. On receipt of the application form, the candidate's present Principal may be asked to provide a confidential report to the Headmaster of Scots College.
4. The Board reserves the right not to award any or all of the Scholarships offered if the candidates do not reach the required standard.
5. Successful candidates will be required to conform to the curriculum and rules of Scots College.
6. Scots College is a Presbyterian Church School and a successful candidate is expected to participate fully and willingly in the Christian aspect of its curriculum.
7. The fee for the Scholarship application is \$25.00 (GST incl.) per candidate and is to be made payable to Scots College and attached to the application.
