- We will respect peoples' belongings and not interfere with their property.
- Our special character involves encouragement and kindness. We will not accept unkind actions or remarks even if these are not intended to hurt or offend.
- This is a school community built on values of care and consideration. We need to realise that we should support each other by reporting instances of bullying.
- Strength of character is important to us. We should be strong enough to stop others from bullying.
- Bullying is too important not to report.
- Bullying will be dealt with seriously.
- The code applies equally to everyone.
