



## Digital Acceptable Use Agreement for Parents / Caregivers of Scots College:

- I understand that, without a signed DIGITAL Acceptable Use Agreement, my child (ren) will not be given access to the College's network.
- I understand that my child (ren) submitted a signed Digital AUA agreement. In this, they agreed that, by connecting their personal device(s) to the College's network or while using College devices and/or resources, they will abide by the following conditions:
- They will not share their password
  - They will not log onto others' devices with their credentials, whether those others are associated with Scots College or not
  - They endeavour to log out of College-provided devices when they are finished using them
  - They will use the provided software, cloud and network storage and other such technologies for completing school work only
  - That none of their devices contained material that could be considered objectionable or deemed inappropriate.
  - They will not use the network or their device(s) in a manner that is harmful to the well-being of staff or students, interfere with other users' work or that is disruptive nor damaging to College resources.
  - They will not intentionally access, store or distribute material that is objectionable, pornographic, or otherwise unsuitable. I understand that to do so may result in suspension or termination of their access privileges and, in extreme cases, the authorities may be informed.
  - They will not illegally access, download and/or store content (such as but not limited to images, music, games, movies, software or inappropriate material) through the use of VPN's, peer-to-peer services or any other method. I understand transmission of any material in violation of any New Zealand law is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to copyrighted material, threatening or obscene material or material protected by trade secret. These activities are strictly forbidden, and severe consequences could follow the breach of this policy.
  - They / We will be personally liable for any breach of copyright, privacy, intellectual property and/or other such rights committed while connected to the College's network.
  - They will not use the Scots College network for personal financial gain
  - They will not knowingly introduce viruses, malware, spam or other such disruptive technologies to the College's network.
  - In the event of their device(s) containing and distributing either a virus, malware, spam or other rogue application that causes disruption or loss of service to the Scots College network, they/we may be liable for some or all of any repair costs incurred.
  - I understand that basic internet security is provided with the connection to the Wireless Network, but that their device(s) need to be protected by personal security software (eg anti-virus, malware protection etc).
  - I confirm that Scots College will NOT be liable for any damage to hardware or corruption of software caused by connection of his device(s) to the Network. Nor is the College responsible for insurance of their device(s). Repairs are attempted in good faith and the College does not accept responsibility for any damages or hardware failure.
  - I understand that Scots College reserves the right to monitor all internet, email and other activity on all devices connected to the College's network and associated technologies at any time and the Headmaster, Principals and/or IT Staff may suspend or terminate their computer/network use privileges if they violate any conditions or other acceptable use practices, and further disciplinary action may be taken.
  - Scots College reserves the right to refuse connection to the Wireless Network for any reason.
